Bigfoot seen at British Hills, Fukushima

A staff member at British Hills, an English-language training institute in Fukushima, claims to have seen Bigfoot on the night of April 24th.

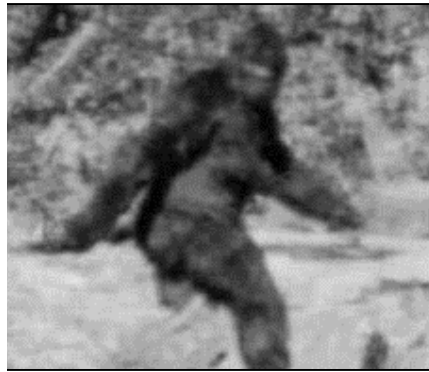
In a statement, Cleatus Biggums, 27, said he saw the creature in the evening while leaving work. Video taken by Biggums of a large creature was shown to news media, and giant footprints were found in the same area the next day.

In North American folklore, Bigfoot is a large, gorilla-like animal similar to the Asian Yeti.

However, other staff were quick to challenge the claims. Coworkers said that Mr. Biggums has previously claimed to see UFOs, Kappa, and the Loch Ness Monster. Some also stated that he has a drinking problem.

The video shows a large, ape-like creature walking through the forest. However, the image is unclear, as the video was filmed at night and the images are blurry.

Mr. Biggums is now offering tours for other people also hoping to see Bigfoot. “I want to share this amazing experience with others,” Biggums stated. Tours are on sale for ¥17,000 a night through www.fukushimabigfoot.com.

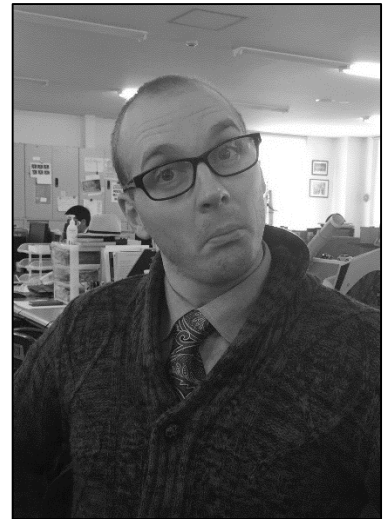
World-leading great apes expert, Dr. Tom Zaius of Tokyo University, has given some support to Mr. Biggums’ claims, saying he has never seen something like the animal in the video.

Dr. Zaius said, “The creature is too large to be human but doesn’t walk like a bear,” adding, “there are no

known gorillas in the Fukushima area, so I have to say that the animal could possibly be a Bigfoot”.

“The footprint evidence is particularly shocking, as the feet are over 50cm in length”.

Dr. Zaius, who has studied apes for more than 30 years, has appeared on several news shows in recent days to give his opinions on the topic.
