**Newfoundland and Labrador** is the easternmost province in Canada. The capital, St. John's, is one of the oldest cities in North America. The province has four UNESCO world heritage sites, including Gros Morne National park, an area of incredible geographic features. If you visit Newfoundland and Labrador, you can go whale watching, see icebergs and try drinks made with iceberg ice.

**Quebec City** is the capital city of Quebec, where French is the main language. Quebec City is the only walled city in the Canada and America and is a UNESCO world heritage site. There are also many beautiful historical buildings. And in the winter, the city has outdoor ice skating rinks and sledding.

**Kluane National Park** is a massive park in the northeast of Canada. The park has the tallest mountain in Canada, Mt. Logan. The park was declared a UNESCO site because of its glaciers and ice field landscapes. Many people visit to go hiking, mountain climbing, camping and to see the Northern lights or aurora borealis.
